Unit 3 "Future intentions" Grammar: be going to, was/were going to, be about to after, before, when, while, as soon as. **Vocabulary:** life events, intentions and ambitions, illness, injuries and accidents. **Reading:** the Paralympics. **Listening:** James Cracknell an inspirational life. **Speaking:** discussing people who overcome a major difficulty. **Writing:** overcoming a major difficulty. A description of a picture.

Unit 4 "Arrangements" Grammar: future forms, present continuous, present simple, be going to, shall/will. **Vocabulary:** vehicles and transport, holidays. **Reading:** Welcome to New Zealand. **Listening:** a trip to New Zealand. **Speaking:** talking about future arrangements and timetables, planning a holiday. **Writing:** an email about your holiday plans

Unit 5 "Jobs in the house" Grammar: have to /don't have to, must/mustn't. **Vocabulary:** jobs in the house, social networking. **Reading:** Lazy teens who don't have to cook, wash or clean. **Listening:** Jade a young carer's story. **Speaking:** talking about obligations, rules and laws. **Writing:** a report giving your opinion about chores. A report on a survey.
